Rome, Italy 5-Day Solo Itinerary

Focus: History, Food & Photography | Mid-Range Budget

Day 1: Arrival & Ancient Rome Highlights

- Morning/afternoon: Arrive from Istanbul and transfer to your hotel in the historic center (recommend areas: Pantheon, Navona or near Termini).
- Explore the Colosseum and Roman Forum (buy skip-the-line tickets online in advance). Best light for photography is late afternoon.
- Evening: Stroll to the Pantheon at golden hour for stunning photos, then enjoy authentic Roman pasta at Da Baffetto or Armando al Pantheon.
- Practical tip: Use the Metro (Line B) or walk; wear comfortable shoes for cobblestones.

Day 2: Vatican & Classical Photography

- Morning: Visit Vatican Museums and Sistine Chapel (book early morning slot to avoid crowds). Photography is allowed in most areas except Sistine Chapel.
- Afternoon: Explore St. Peter's Basilica and climb the dome for panoramic views of Rome (highly recommended for photographers).
- Evening: Relax with aperitivo in Trastevere; try carbonara or cacio e pepe at Da Teo or Roma Sparita.
- Practical tip: Take Metro Line A to Ottaviano station. Bring a small daypack and water.

Day 3: Capitoline Hill, Markets & Street Food

- Morning: Visit Capitoline Museums and enjoy the panoramic terrace overlooking the Roman Forum — perfect for wide-angle shots.
- Explore Campo de' Fiori market in the morning, then wander the Jewish Ghetto for history and great food.
- Lunch: Try traditional Roman dishes at Nonna Betta or Boccione bakery for delicious Jewish-Roman pastries.
- Evening: Sunset photography at the Spanish Steps and Trevi Fountain (less crowded after 7pm).
- Practical tip: Everything is walkable. Mid-range dinner budget: €25–35 per meal.

Day 4: Trastevere, Tiber River & Local Life

- Morning: Cross the Tiber River to the charming Trastevere neighborhood. Wander the colorful streets and take artistic street photography.
- Visit Villa Farnesina and the Botanical Garden for peaceful green spaces and unique photo opportunities.
- Afternoon: Free time for gelato at Giolitti or Frigidarium, then explore the Mouth of Truth and Circus Maximus.
- Evening: Enjoy a relaxed dinner with local wine at Osteria da Zi Umberto or similar mid-range trattoria.
- Practical tip: Best time for Trastevere photos is morning or late afternoon when light is soft.

Day 5: Modern Rome, Shopping & Departure

- Morning: Visit the Altare della Patria (Victor Emmanuel II Monument) for rooftop views — one of the best 360° photography spots in Rome.
- Stroll through Piazza Navona and admire Bernini's fountains, then do some souvenir shopping on Via del Corso.
- Depending on your flight time, grab a final espresso and tiramisu before heading to the airport.
- Practical tip: Book your airport transfer the night before; Leonardo Express train or private transfer recommended.
