Paris 6-Day Couples Itinerary (Mid-Budget)

Day 1: Arrival and First Look at Paris

- Morning flight from Istanbul to Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport, transfer to the city center by RER B train (the most economical and fastest method)
- Afternoon walk in the Le Marais district; Place des Vosges and historic streets
- Evening romantic walk around Notre-Dame Cathedral and along the Seine River
- Dinner: Mid-range French bistro in Le Marais (e.g. L'As du Fallafel or a classic brasserie)
- Tip: Get a metro card (Paris Visite or Navigo Easy), wear comfortable shoes.

Day 2: Iconic Paris - History and Culture

- Early morning visit to the Eiffel Tower (around 09:00 to avoid queues)
- Lunch: Creperie or affordable café near the Tour Eiffel
- Afternoon visit to the Louvre Museum (Mona Lisa, Venus de Milo, etc.)
- Evening walk along Champs-Élysées and at the Arc de Triomphe
- Night: 1-hour evening boat tour on the Seine River (Bateaux Parisiens)
- Tip: Purchase Louvre tickets online, allocate at least 3 hours.

Day 3: Montmartre and Romantic Paris

- Morning visit to Sacré-Cœur Basilica and climb up the Montmartre hill for panoramic views of Paris

- Lunch: Typical French creperie or around “La Maison Rose”
- Afternoon watch the artists at Place du Tertre, shopping in boutiques
- Evening lively nightlife and cocktail bars around Moulin Rouge
- Romantic dinner: One of the mid-budget bistros in Montmartre
- Tip: Montmartre is very hilly, comfortable shoes are essential.

Day 4: Culture, Shopping and Flavors

- Morning visit to the Orsay Museum (ideal for impressionist art lovers)
- Afternoon shopping at Le Bon Marché or Galeries Lafayette (be sure to see Lafayette’s magnificent dome)
- Dinner: Classic French cuisine in Saint-Germain-des-Prés (mid-range restaurant suggestion: near Café de Flore or Les Deux Magots)
- Night: Bar hopping and lively nightlife in the Latin Quarter
- Tip: Shopping is less crowded in the afternoon.

Day 5: Versailles and Parisian Cuisine

- Go to Versailles Palace by early morning train (40 min with RER C)
- Explore the palace and gardens (especially magnificent in spring/summer)
- Upon return to Paris, romantic dinner in Le Marais or Canal Saint-Martin
- Night: Nightlife at trendy cocktail bars (e.g. Candelaria or Little Red Door)
- Tip: Buy Versailles tickets online, allocate at least 4 hours.

Day 6: Last Day - Relaxed Exploration and Departure

- Morning walk and coffee break at Luxembourg Gardens
- Lunch: Poilâne or Ladurée for the best macarons and bread
- Afternoon final shopping or picnic by the Seine
- Transfer to the airport before dinner (via RER B)
- Tip: Keep the last day light, leave space in your suitcase.
